We will be participating in this program with Aldersgate church. The goal is to raise \$500. There will be a poster with our progress updated each week. Boxes are due the week following Halloween.

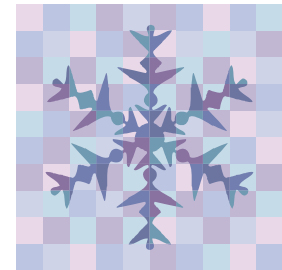
Winter Clothing Drive October 23-30th
